



## Newborn Conditions

With respect to infants who have not had the Gillespie Approach at birth, we expect correction with complete treatment for the following conditions:

- Nursing issues like the inability to latch on, difficulty in sucking, and difficulty in swallowing.
- Reflux
- Colic
- Constipation
- Digestive issues (gas)
- Napping/sleeping issues (crying/distress/fussiness)
- Pyloric stenosis
- Stridor
- Clubfoot (treated as close to birth as possible, before surgery)

Treatment can be very helpful but may not correct the following neurological issues:

- Epilepsy (seizures)
- Cerebral palsy
- Downs syndrome
- Blindness
- Deafness
- Strabismus
